

# GARMIN GPSmap 60CSx

## Simple Instructions – Part 2

### (Creating and Using Waypoints)

#### Marking Your Current Location

Use the **MARK** button to quickly capture your current location to create a new waypoint.

*Reminder:* You must have a valid position (locked on satellites) to mark your current location.

*Example:* Let's say you are at a search and you want to mark Command's location.

1. Press and hold the **MARK** button until the Mark Waypoint Page appears. A three digit number and symbol (at the top of the page) are assigned to that waypoint.
2. Use the arrow button to highlight that three digit number, and press **ENTER** to open the on-screen keypad.
3. Use the arrow button to highlight the letter "**C**", and press **ENTER**. Enter each letter to spell **Command**.
4. Highlight **OK** in the on-screen keypad, and press **ENTER**.
5. The waypoint should now be saved into your GPS (unless you press quit), but to be absolutely sure it is saved, highlight **OK** in the bottom right corner of the screen, and press **ENTER**.

Command's location is now entered, and saved into your GPS. Repeat steps 1-5 if you want to mark your car (name it car), a clue, the subject, or any point of interest.

To change the waypoint's symbol:

1. Highlight the symbol (to the left of the word command), and press **ENTER**.
2. Highlight a symbol from the different categories, and press **ENTER**.

## Creating a Waypoint Using Coordinates

You can manually enter location coordinates to create a waypoint.

*Example:* Let's say command wants you to go to a specific UTM position (18 T 0377440 4457208).

1. Press the **MARK** button.
2. On the Waypoint Page, highlight the UTM coordinates below the word **Location**, and press **ENTER** to open the on-screen keypad.
3. Use the arrow button to highlight the number "1", and press **ENTER**. Enter each number to get (18 T 0377440 4457208).
4. Highlight **OK** in the on-screen keypad, and press **ENTER**.
5. The coordinates should now be saved into your GPS (unless you press quit), but to be absolutely sure it is saved, highlight **OK** in the bottom right corner of the screen, and press **ENTER**.

*Note:* If you must change the letter "T", use the vertical arrows in the on-screen keypad.

## Deleting Waypoints

If a waypoint is no longer needed, You can delete that waypoint from the Waypoint Page.

To delete a waypoint:

1. Press **FIND** to open the Find Menu.
2. Highlight the **Waypoints** icon, and press **ENTER**.
3. Select the waypoint you want to delete, and press **ENTER**.
4. Highlight **DELETE**, and press **ENTER**. A confirmation message appears.
5. Highlight **YES**, and press **ENTER**.
